

Coats Pension Plan The Coats Foundation Trust



The Coats Foundation Trust is a charity which was established by Coats with the aim of helping to relieve poverty and to assist in funding education for those who do not have the financial means to study.

If an individual is suffering financial hardship, the Trust does not have funds which would enable regular payments (like a pension) to the individual, but may be able to help with a one-off payment to buy essential items, such as equipment or furniture, or towards essential repairs where no other source of funding from the public coffers or other charitable institution is available.

To request assistance, applicants should write to us at the Glasgow Office, giving full details of the reason for application, and provide copies of any documents which will back the claim, such as a statement of income and outgoings. The applicant should also include details of what the extra money is needed for and the cost of the item or items.

For educational funding assistance the applicant should include a university reference to back the claim and any additional supporting information.

We cannot accept applications for normal day-to-day items like food and rent as this would be a long-term need which our limited funds could not permit. Details should be included of any other sources of funding that the individual has applied for or may expect help from, together with any other information that will help the Trustee in considering the case.

We do not make payments to other charities as our policy is to assist individual cases direct.
